Na Španovem vrhu so leta 1947 postavili vlečno žičnico, ki je veljala za prvo v Jugoslaviji. Smučišče je bilo zelo pomembno, saj so na njem potekale priprave takratne olimpijske alpske smučarske reprezentance, pozneje pa tudi različna alpska smučarska tekmovanja vse do državnega nivoja. Enosedelna je bila postavljena leta 1964.

Pobočja Španovega vrha maja pobelijo narcise ali ključavnice, kot jim pravijo domačini. Te prelepe bele cvetice se ohranjajo s tradicionalnim načinom kmetovanja ter redno pozno košnjo v juniju. Narcise so redka in ogrožena rastlinska vrsta, zato so zaščitena tudi njihova rastišča.

V pravljici je izvor imena ključavnica razložen tako:

"Nekoč je Bog posvaril čebele, naj nikar ne delajo in nabirajo medu ob nedeljah in praznikih. Čebele pa ga niso ubogale in zato jim je med v ključavnicah 'zaključil'. Dočim je namreč sladki sok poprej neovirano prihajal v cvet, je Bog takrat rastlinam pod cvetom v stebelcu ustvaril bunčico in z njo soku zaprl dohod v cvet, da ga čebele ne morejo več skrati."

ŠPANOV VRH

In 1947 a ski tow was made on Španov vrh, which was considered the first one in Yugoslavia. The ski slopes were very important as the then Olympic Alpine ski team was training there and later on several alpine skiing competitions up to the national level were held there. A single-chair lift was constructed in 1964.

In May the slopes of Španov vrh become a white carpet of daffodils, called 'ključavnice' (locks) by local people. These beautiful white flowers can be preserved only by the traditional way of farming and regular late mowing in June. Daffodils are rare and endangered plant species and therefore daffodil sites are protected as well.

The origin of the word 'ključavnica' is explained in a fairy tale:

"Once upon a time God warned bees not to work and gather honey on Sundays and feast days. Bees did not obey him so God „locked“ honey in daffodils. The sweet sap used to flow into the blossom but God created a small bump on the stalk below the blossom which prevented the sap from flowing into the blossom and bees cannot sip it anymore."
